An Clár Bí Sábhálte: Stay Safe Programme

Is clár scileanna sábhailteachta pearsanta do bhunscoileanna é an clár Bí Sábhálte. Tá sé mar aidhm ag an gclár drochíd ar leanai a chosc mar aon le saghasanna eile ansmachta a chosc freisin. Müintear an clár i gcomhthéacs Oideachas sláinte, phearsanta agus sóisialta (OSPS). Tá an clár bunaithe ar na buneilimintí seo a leanas :

1. Féin-mheas leanáí a chothú
2. Féin-mhuinín leanáí a chothú
3. Cabhrú le leanáí a bheith teanntásach
4. Cabhrú le leanáí a gcuid mothúchán a aithint agus a chur in iúl.

Ar nós straite eile de churaclam OSPS is próiseas comhoibrithe idir tuismitheoirí agus müinteoirí é cur i bhfeidhm an chláir Bí Sábhálte chun leanaí a choimeád slán sábhálte agus chun drochíd ar leanáí a chosc trí oideachas i scileanna sábhálteachta. Beidh rialacha foghlamtha ag an gcuid is mó de na leanaí a chabhróidh leo iad féin a chosaint, m.sh. sábhálteacht bóthair agus sábhálteacht uisce. Ba chóir go mbeadh sábhálteacht phearsanta ina chuid nádúrtha d'oideachas gach linbh.

Múineann an clár Bí Sábhálte do leanaí conas iad féin a chosaint ach ag an am céanna fágann sé acu an tuiscint gur áit shlán go bunúsach é an domhan timpeall orthu. Déantar scileanna de na straitéisí, dá bhrí sin, a bheidh mar chuid d'iompar féinchosanta an linbh.

Is iad na hAIDHMEANNA atá ag an gclár ná

- Cabhrú le leanáí mothúcháin atá sábhálte agus nach bhfuil sábhálte a aithint agus a chur in iúl.
- Na scileanna sábhailteachta chun déileáil le gnáth-ócáidí neamhshábháilteachta ar nós a bheith ag dul amú a mhúineadh do na leanaí.
- Na leanaí a spraegadh chun meas a bheith acu ar chairdeas agus scileanna a mhuineadh dóibh a bhaineann le cairde a dhéanamh agus a choimeád.
- Na straitéisí sábhailteachta chun déileáil le bulaíocht a mhúineadh do na leanaí.
- A mhúineadh do na leanaí nach nglactar le bulaíocht ar dhaoine eile.
- Leanaí a spreagadh chun meas a bheith acu ar ghnáthchionn agus taitneamh a bhaint as.
- A mhúineadh do leanaí conas déileáil le teagmháil choirp atá mí-oiriúnach nó neamhshábhailte.
- An riail a mhúineadh – ná coimeád teagmháil choirp go deo faoi rún.
- Cabhrú leis na leanaí an difear idir run ata go maith agus rún nach bhfuil go maith a aithint.
- Cabhrú leis na leanaí na daoine fásta arbh fhéidir leo drochrún a roinnt leo, a liostáil agus deis a thabhairt dóibh cleachtadh ar insint a dhéanamh.
- A shoiléiriú do leanaí cad is strainséirí ann

Stay Safe Programme: An Clár Bí Sábháilte

The Stay Safe programme is a personal safety skills programme for primary schools. Its overall objective is to prevent child abuse and other forms of child victimisation. This programme is taught within the broader context of Social, personal and health education (SPHE). It is based on the following core elements, each of which is an integral part of the SPHE curriculum.

1. Nurturing children's self esteem
2. Building children's confidence
3. Enabling children to be assertive
4. Helping children to identify and express their feelings.

In common with other strands of the SPHE curriculum the Stay Safe programme is a collaborative process which involves parents and teachers taking a co-ordinated approach to child protection through safety skills education. Most children will already have learned rules which are designed to protect them, such as road safety or water safety. Personal safety should be a natural part of every child's education.

The Stay Safe programme teaches children prevention, while preserving their sense of the world around them as a basically safe and secure place. This approach allows children to exercise control, to be assertive, and enables them to seek help for any problems they may encounter. The programme teaches simple strategies for dealing with various potentially dangerous situations and children are given the opportunity to practise these strategies in the classroom. Thus, the concepts are translated into skills which become part of the child's repertoire of self-protective behaviour.

The OBJECTIVES of the programme are:

- To help children to identify and express safe & unsafe feelings
- To teach children safety skills for dealing with common unsafe situations like getting lost.
- To encourage children to value friendship and to teach them skills for making and keeping friends.
- To teach children safety strategies for dealing with bullying.
- To teach children that it is not acceptable to bully others.
- To encourage children to value and enjoy normal affection.
- To teach children how to deal with an unsafe or an inappropriate touch.
- To teach the rule – never to keep secrets about touching.
- To help the children to recognise the difference between a good secret and a bad secret.
- To help children identify the adults they could tell if they had a bad secret and to give them the opportunity to practice telling.
- To clarify for the children who strangers are.
- To give children safety strategies for dealing appropriately with strangers.
