

Seachtain na Gaeilge : **Beatha Teanga í a Labhairt!**

N'fheadar an bhfuil mórán agaibh ag féachaint ar an G-Team ar TG4 le roinnt seachtainí anuas ach 'sé Lorcán Mac Gabhann (Cathaoirleach ár mBord Bainistíochta agus bunaitheoir na scoile) atá mar phríomh moltóir ar an gclár ie Simon Cowell na Gaeilge! Muna bhfuil sé feicthe agaibh is fiú go mór féachaint ar ar TG4 Player. 'Seard atá sa 'G-Team' ná comórtas idir bhailte beaga ar fud na hÉireann agus dúshlán á thabhairt dóibh G-Day – lá na Gaeilge, a eagrú sa bhaile trí féile a eagrú ina ndéantar ceiliúradh ar dhúchas, ar chultúr agus ar thraidisiún an bhaile sin agus gach rud á rith agus á dhéanamh trí Ghaeilge. Beidh €40,000 mar dhuais ag an mbaile a bhuann an comórtas seo.

Le 'Seachtain na Gaeilge' faoi lán tseoil cheanna féin sa scoil agus lá 'le Pádraig ag teacht gan mhoill taim ag súil go ndéanfaidh gach tuismitheoir sár-iarracht cibé Gaeilge atá acu a labhairt thart timpeall na scoile. Muna ndéanann beidh mé ag cur fios ar Lorcán agus a chomh-mholtóirí (Mary Hannafin and Rossa Ó Snodaigh) le teacht isteach agus focal láidir a bheith acu libh!

Go mí-ábharach níl €40,000 de dhuaiseanna agamsa le bronnadh ar na tuismitheoirí a dhéanann an t-iarracht is fearr an Ghaeilge a labhairt ach beidh ár G-Team féin (moltóirí óna hardranganna) ag éisteach libh sa chlós agus thart timpeall na scoile agus bronnfaidh siadsan duaiseanna beaga go laethúil ar na tuismitheoirí a dhéanann an t-iarracht is mó!

I don't know if any of you have been watching the G-Team on TG4 over the last few weeks but our very own Lorcán Mac Gabhann (chairperson of the Board of Management and founder of the school) features as the main judge in the show ie Simon Cowell na Gaeilge! If you haven't watched it you should check it out on TG4 Player. The programme throws down the gauntlet to small towns and villages throughout Ireland to compete in a battle to become the top Irish speaking town outside the Gaeltacht. Each programme featured 2 villages of similar size and they had to organise a 'G-Day' – Gaeilge Day. On that day the villages put on a festival celebrating their heritage, local traditions etc. and everything had to be carried out 'as Gaeilge'. The overall winner of the series will walk away with 40K for their village.

With St. Patrick's Day fast approaching and 'Seachtain na Gaeilge' well underway in school I'm asking all parents to start brushing up on their Gaeilge as I'll be expecting everyone to make a greater effort to speak whatever Gaeilge they have in and around the school - if not I'll be calling on Lorcán Mac Gabhann and his fellow judges (Mary Hannafin and Rossa Ó Snodaigh) to come in to have a few words with you!

Unfortunately I don't have 40k to hand out in prize money however our very own G-Team (some of our senior pupils) will be listening very carefully to you in the 'clós' and around the school and they will be presenting small prizes on a daily basis to the parents they deem to be making the greatest effort!

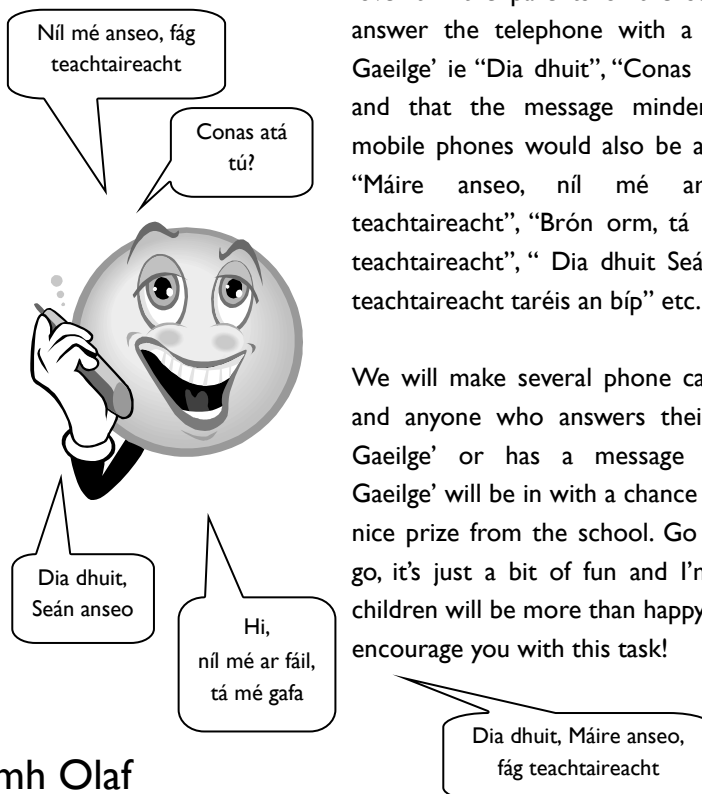

On March 9th 2010, a marathon run began around the island of Ireland, passing the specially designed baton to a different runner/group at the end of each kilometre. Over 20,000 people ran to support the Irish language, on a cross-country route through cities, towns and villages between Belfast and Galway.

Rith 2012 will be starting on the 8th of March (today) in Gaoth Dobhair and finishing up 10 days later on Inis Mór, in the Aran Islands. Rith will visit Counties Donegal, Tyrone, Derry, Antrim, Armagh, Monaghan, Meath, Dublin, Kildare, Carlow, Laois, Tipperary, Limerick, Clare, Galway and the Aran Islands.

Rith 2012 is coming through our locality on Monday next the 12th of March and the pupils from R5 and R6 will be carrying the baton for the 1km from Wykham Way to the Sandyford Road in Dundrum (between 1pm -1.30pm).
