Congratulations to the senior football team for qualifying for Cumann na mBunscol's Corn an Chéid final. The team will take on Lucan's Gaelscoil Naomh Pádraig in the Croke Park decider on Tuesday 13th of December at 11.45am.






Tacaíocht dár bPeileadóirí Support Our Footballers



De réir mar a thagann fás & forbairt ar Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille éireoidh sé níos deacra fós áiteanna a fháil dár bpáistí i gColáiste Eoin/Iosagáin agus cibé patrún a roghnaítear don scoil nua seo táimidne thar a bheith sásta go mbeidh rogha meanscolaíocht lán-ghaeilge againn sa cheantar seo rud a chinnteoidh go mbeidh ár ndaltaí in ann leanúint tríd an gcóras oideachais lán-Ghaeilge ag an dara leibhéal.

The Department of Education has announced that they plan to open a new Irish language Secondary school in Dundrum in 2014. Department of Education rules about the establishment of new schools means that the patron of the school will be chosen on a competitive basis. All interested patron bodies have been invited to apply to become patron of this new secondary school. The Department, on viewing the submissions from the prospective patrons, will then decide who will ultimately be the patron of the new school.

Two patron bodies have expressed an interest in this new secondary school, An FORAS PATRÚNACHTA & the COUNTY DUBLIN VOCATIONAL EDUCATION COMMITTEE (VEC) and both intend submitting an application to Department of Education requesting to be patron of this new school. Both committees held a public meeting to inform parents about the new school and their patronage and they were delighted with the turnout at both meetings and the great interest and support shown by the parents from Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille who were in attendance (22/11/11 An FORAS PATRÚNACHTA and 19/11/11 VEC)



We have been campaigning for a long time for the establishment of a new secondary Gaelscoil in South Dublin as the demand for places in Coláiste Eoin/Iosagáin greatly exceeds the places available in both schools. As Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille grows it will become increasingly difficult to get a place in Coláiste Eoin/Iosagáin and whichever one of the patron bodies the Department of Education decide will manage the school we are delighted that there will be a second All-Irish Secondary school in this area and that our children will be able to continue their education 'as Gaeilge' at second level.

Ag labhairt ag Comhdháil Bhliantiúil agus Oideachais 2011 a d'oscail inniu ar an Tulach Mhór, dheimhnhigh príomhthaighdeoir an Fhorais Taighde, an Dr. Shiel gurb é seo an chéad uair riamh a rinneadh tástálacha ar fhormhór na scoileanna lán-Ghaeilge agus Gaeltachta mar aonad samplach iontu féin ar ghnóthachtáil sa Bhéarla agus sa mhata. Daingníonn na dea-thorthaí seo torthaí ó thaighde dhúchasach neamhspleách eile atá déanta in Éirinn agus tagann siad le dea-thorthaí an tuimheachais ar bhonn idirnáisiúnta.

Tagann na dea-thorthaí seo sna sála ar thaighde an NCE-MSTL (an Lárionad Sármhaitheasa i bhFoghlaim agus Teagasc an Mhata agus an Eolaíocht) a léiríonn go bhfuil buntáistí trí chur chuige an dátheangachais i gceist don pháiste i bhfoghlaim an mhata in Éirinn.

The Standard of English and Mathematics in Irish-medium Schools above the national average

GAELSCOILEANNA TEO. welcomes today's announcement by the Education Research Institute that the standard of English and mathematics in Irish-medium schools is well above the national average. Speaking at the Annual Education Conference 2011, which opened today in Tullamore, Dr. Gerry Shiel, chief researcher with the ERC confirmed that this was the first time that the majority of Irish-medium and Gaeltacht primary schools were assessed on their achievement levels in English and mathematics as an independent cohort. These positive results reinforce results of other independent native research and support the much documented international research findings on the benefits of immersion education. Today's results compound recent research findings of the NCE-MSTL (The Centre of Excellence in the Learning and Teaching of Mathematics and Science) which verify the benefits of a bilingual approach to learning mathematics in Ireland for the child.

New report highlights the benefits of bilingualism for mathematics students in Ireland

A new report investigating the impacts of bilingualism in the study of mathematics in Ireland was launched recently by Minister for Research and Innovation, Sean Sherlock TD. Published by the National Centre for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching and Learning (NCE-MSTL) at the University of Limerick, the report is based on a doctoral study completed by Dr Máire Ní Ríordáin, former Senior Projects Officer at the NCE-MSTL and currently Head of Education at St Patrick's College, Thurles.

The report reveals **previously unnoticed advantages to a bilingual approach to mathematics** education. The study found that learning mathematics through the medium of Gaeilge at primary level education may **enhance long-term mathematical understanding and attainment** in English-medium second level education. Bilingual students in 2nd and 3rd level education with **high ability in both Irish and English outperformed their monolingual peers** in mathematics, even when assessed through their second language of learning, English.


Speaking at the launch of the report, Minister for Research and Innovation, Sean Sherlock said; "This report adds new evidence-based analyses on language issues in mathematics education that are timely in terms of the national Irish language policy debate, formulation and implementation. A major finding of the study points to the advantages of bilingualism for education."

The aim of the study was to **investigate Irish post-primary and undergraduate bilingual mathematics students'** experiences of learning mathematics through the medium of English, their second language of learning.

Dr. Máire Ní Ríordáin, author of the report said; "The study noted some drops in performance in the transition from Gaeilge-medium primary level to English-medium second level; however these were only experienced in the initial transition and are specific to having English as the new language of learning. The advantages of being bilingual can outweigh the negatives once proficiency is developed in both languages."
