

Taispeántas Seachtain na hEolaíochta Science Week Exhibition



Chuir daltaí R4 - R6 taispeántas eolaíochta ar siúl do dhaltáí uile na scoile ar an Déardaoin 21 Mí na Samhna. 52 turgnaimh ar an iomlán a bhí ann. Chaith na daltaí breis is seachtain ag ullmhú don lá ó thús Seachtain na hEolaíochta agus ba léir ón gcaighdeán turgnaimh a bhí le feiceáil sa halla ar an lá go raibh an-obair déanta sna seomra ranga mar ullmhúchán ar an lá mór.

Ina measc bhí:

Turgnamh a rinne Isobel Nic Óda agus Niamh Nic Uidhir (R6B) ciorcad leictreach as clog agus úlla. Tá leictirlítí sna húlla agus nuair a cheanglaíonn tú iad chun ciorcaid a dhéanamh, úsáidtear an leictreachas seo chun an clog a chur ar siúl.

Léirigh James Ó Géargáin, Jack Mag Fhloinn, Red Goodhue agus Alex Holden (R6A) na Beebots, Fionnán Ó Dubhthaigh agus Liam Townsend (R6B) na Makey Makeys agus Zoe Ní Lionáin, Sadhbh Nic Íomhair agus Regan Ní Bhriain (R6B) na Skri-bots.

Is iomaí turgnaimh a bhí ann ó imoibríthe ceimiceach go lampa laibhe, ó roicéad balún go Oobleck, ó thriail a léirigh dlús go luascadán.

Pupils from Rang a 4 - Rang a 6 participated in Science Day on Thursday 21st. 52 different exhibits were on show in the school hall during the day and the whole school got an opportunity to view them. The pupils began planning and preparing for Science Day a week earlier at the beginning of Science Week. It was evident from the standard of experiments on display that the work carried out in the classroom had borne fruit.

Examples of the projects on display were:

Isobel Nic Óda and Niamh Nic Uidhir's (R6B) demonstration of an electric circuit created simply with a clock and apples. The apples contain electrolytes which conduct electricity, and in turn, generate enough electricity to operate the clock.

James Ó Géargáin, Jack Mag Fhloinn, Red Goodhue & Alex Holden (R6A) demonstrated the Beebots, Fionnán and Liam Townsend (R6B) the Makey Makeys and Zoe Ní Lionáin, Sadhbh Nic Íomhair & Regan Ní Bhriain (R6B) the Skri-bots.

There was a wide range of experiments on display from chemical reactions to lava lamps, from a balloon rocket to Oobleck and from a trial demonstrating density to that of a pendulum.

Seachtain na hEolaíochta Science Week ar lean



Léirigh Hugh Mac Giolla Bhríde conas a oibríonn ciorcad tré cheistneoir 'Fíor' nó 'Bréagach' a dhearadh. D'úsáid sé cadhnra, sreanga leictreach, a ghníomhaigh mar sheoltóir chun sruth leictreach a shreabhadh agus bolgáin solais a lasadh. Nuair a d'fhreagair páiste freagra i gceart, bhí a ciorcad iomlán agus las na soilse. Dúirt Hugh gur bhain sé an-taitneamh as an turgnamh a dhéanamh agus a thaispeáint do na daltaí eile.

Rinne Rosa Nic Giolla Mhuire agus Lucy Laighéis (R4B) turgnamh a léirigh dúch do-fheicthe. Thug siad deis do pháistí teachtaireachtaí rúnda a scríobh ar pháipéar bán ag baint úsáide as sú líomóin. Ní raibh tú ábalta an teachtaireacht a léamh go dtí go ndearna siad an páipéar a théamh. Tagann athrú ar dhath aigéad citreach nuair a thagann an carbón, a scaoiltear amach mar thoradh ar an teas, i dteagmháil le haer. Dá bharr sin, is féidir an teachtaireacht a léamh.

Bhaineamar ar fad an-taitneamh go deo as na taispeán-tais eolaíochta agus is cinnte gur ardaigh sé spéis na ndaltaí i gcúrsaí eolaíochta.

Hugh Mac Giolla Bhríde (R6B) designed a circuit based on 'True' or 'False' questions. He used a battery, connecting wires to act as a conductor to flow electric current to light bulbs. Once a pupil answered correctly, all the parts of the circuit were connected, the current flowed and the lights lit up. Hugh said that he really enjoyed designing and making the circuit and also demonstrating it to the whole school.



Rosa Nic Giolla Mhuire and Lucy Laighéis (R4B) demonstrated an experiment on invisible ink. Using lemon juice, they invited children to write an invisible message on a piece of paper. The compounds contained in the lemon juice break down once heated and carbon is released. The carbons oxidise, as they come into contact with air, and turn brown, resulting in the 'hidden message' becoming visible.

Everybody really enjoyed the science exhibition and it certainly helped to awaken the pupils curiosity & interest in all things science.

Cór Náisiúnta na nÓg

National Children's Choir

Eispéireas córuil scoilbhunaithe do pháistí bunscoile is ea Cór Náisiúnta na nÓg. Foghlaimíonn daltaí ó ranganna 4, 5 nó 6 i mBunscoileanna na hÉireann stór comónta amhrán a shásaíonn go leor cuspóirí an chlár cheoil ag leibhéal sinsearach na bunscoile.

Foghlaimíonn na páistí an stór amhrán ina scoileanna féin, múinte ag a gcuid múinteoirí féin, agus téann siad le scoileanna áitiúla eile cúpla uair sa bhliain chun na hamhráin seo a chleachtadh le Stiúrthóir Ceoil Cúnta áitiúil. Glacann gach páiste páirt i gceolchoirm áitiúil (sa lárionad Náisiúnta Cispheile i dTamhlacht i mí Márta/Aibreán), agus téann céatadán de na páistí sin ar stáitse sa Cheoláras Náisiúnta, i mBaile Átha Cliath ag deireadh mí Bealtaine.



Tá stair fhada ag Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille le Cór Náisiúnta na nÓg agus páirt glactha ag an scoil 'sna ceolchoirmeacha débhlíantúla seo ó 2003 i leith.

Tá rang a 6 agus 5 ag glacadh páirt i gCór Náisiúnta na nÓg i mbliana. Tagann an ceithre rang le chéile gach Céadaoin ag 1:30 le cleachtadh ar feadh uair a chloig. Tá 15 amhrán ar fad le foghlaim ag an gcór. Tá tús maith curtha againn leis an gcéad 8 amhrán. 'Viva la Vida', an t-amhrán is fearr le go leor de na daltaí faoi láthair. Taitníonn 'Songs of Ireland' linn freisin mar gur measca é d'amhráin ó gach cúige in Éireann. Bainimid an-taitneamh as 'The Rhythm of Life' a chanadh freisin cé go bhfuil sé tapaidh agus dúshlánach mar go bhfuil 3 pháirt inti. Amhrán eile atá á fhoghlaim againn agus a thaitníonn linn is ea 'Caledonia' a bhfuil fonn álainn suaimhneach aici. I measc na n-amhrán eile atá á fhoghlaim tá Speed Your Journey, Mo Ghile Mear, Tír na nÓg agus Thankful.

Beidh ár gcéad ollchleachtadh againn ar an Déardaoin seo nuair a thiocfaidh daltaí R5 & R6 ó Holy Trinity NS agus St Mary's NS go Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille leis na hamhráin ar fad a chleachtadh le chéile. Beidh thart ar 250 dalta ar fad ag an gcleachtadh sin. Táimid ag súil go mór leis.

The National Children's Choir is a school-based choral experience for primary school children. Affiliated pupils from 4th, 5th or 6th classes in Irish Primary Schools learn a common repertoire of songs that more than satisfies many objectives of the music programme at the senior end of the primary school.

The children learn the repertoire in their own schools, taught by their own teachers, and join with other local schools a couple of times a year to rehearse these songs with a local Assistant Musical Director. Every child participates in a local concert (in the Basketball Arena in Tallaght in March/April), and a small percentage of the children perform in the National Concert Hall, Dublin at the end of May.

Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille has a long involvement with the National Children's Choir and the school has participated in the bi-annual concerts since 2003.

R5 & R6 are participating in the National Children's Choir this year. All 4 classes come together for an hour every Wednesday at 1.30pm. The choir has to learn a repertoire of 15 songs. We have already made a good start on the first 8 songs. A firm favourite so far is 'Viva la Vida' by Coldplay. A medley called 'Songs of Ireland' is also quite popular and it includes a song from each county. We also love singing 'The Rhythm of Life' despite the fact that it is very fast and quite challenging as it is sung in 3 parts. Another song we like is 'Caledonia' which is a traditional song with a lovely calming melody. The other songs we are currently learning are, Speed Your Journey, Mo Ghile Mear, Tír na nÓg and Thankful.

We will have our first 'cluster' rehearsal this Thursday when pupils from 5th and 6th classes in Holy Trinity NS and St Mary's NS, Sandyford will come to Gaelscoil Thaobh na Coille for a days rehearsal. There will be approximately 250 pupils at that rehearsal. We are looking forward to the rehearsal and singing as part of a bigger choir.
